Our journey through history will take us from the settlement of the first Colonies through the Civil War. We will conclude the year with the time period after the Civil war known as Reconstruction.

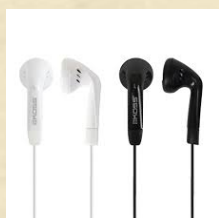

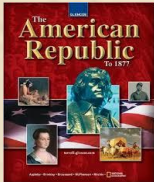
